**This document is for campers who plan to attend our Spring WAM Camp. Please print this document and use as you pack your child for camp. If you have additional questions, please feel free to email or call the camp.**

Spring WAM Camp is focused on music and the arts with fun outdoor activities integrated into the program. It will camp packed with the arts as well as the outdoor adventures that define camp.

- **CLOTHING and EQUIPMENT:** Bring comfortable clothing and be prepared for changes in temperature. It is spring so temperatures can vary widely. You may want to bring a jacket and warmer clothing for the evenings. Also, bring comfortable tennis/walking shoes for hiking. Please send your camper with 2 pairs of shoes to help keep feet dry. Though we don't like it when it rains, come prepared with a poncho or rain jacket. You will enjoy your Cedar Lake experience best if you bring bedding (sleeping bag or sheets and blanket and a pillow), towel, washcloth, soap, other toiletries, sunscreen, a Bible, pen, and a flashlight with batteries. A disposable camera is a lot of fun and help the family back home share the memories. Whatever you bring, we highly encourage you to **MARK ALL YOUR BELONGINGS WITH A PERMANENT MARKER.**
- **SPENDING MONEY:** We recommend placing \$10-20 (T-Shirts are \$10) in your child's Snack Shack account upon arrival. They will have opportunity to buy snacks one most days.. All unused monies are returned upon camper check-out.
- **CONTACTING CAMPERS:** While phone calls and unannounced visits are not encouraged, your camper will love to receive mail and will be encouraged to write at least one letter home. *Placing a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope in your child's gear will facilitate a letter home.* In case of sickness or emergency, we will call you. Should you call here with an emergency, your child will be contacted as soon as possible . If you would like for your child to have a cell phone, we understand, but do not recommend this because of the possibility of losing them or getting them wet. Just note that there will be times when they will not have access to them. We answer the phone at all times during camp, so your child can be reached if necessary.
- **CHECK IN:** Tuesday March 13th between 2:00-4:00 PM (Dining Hall)
- **CHECK-OUT:** Friday March 16h at 10:00AM (Dining Hall)
- **LOST and FOUND:** Just another reminder to pack with your camper so they know what is in the suitcase and what needs to come home. Remember to label all gear, and be sure and look through lost and found during check out.

Children are carefully supervised at all times, so please don't worry. Camp is a fun, important event. We are looking forward to a great camp. Please invite your friends. Let us know if they need a brochure. Cedar Lake is a great place for making new friends as well as spending the week with someone you know. Look forward to seeing you soon!

- Travel for 3.5 miles. After passing Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church, turn right onto Conatser Lane
- Bear Left at Fork
- Turn left at 2nd driveway on the left.
