



This document includes information that you will need if your child plans to be a camper at Summer Resident Camp at Cedar Lake. Please feel free to email us with any additional questions that you may have. clcstaff@cedarlakecamp.org

- **CLOTHING and EQUIPMENT:** Bring shorts and/or cool comfortable clothing. You may want to bring a light jacket or sweatshirt for the cooler evenings. We would ask that young ladies bring a modest one-piece swimsuit. Also, bring comfortable tennis/walking shoes for hiking. Send at least two pairs of shoes so that feet may be kept dry. Though we don't like it when it rains, come prepared with a poncho or rain jacket. We have a nice banquet that your child may want to "dress" up for. (This is more fun than formal) You will enjoy your Cedar Lake experience best if you bring a sleeping bag or sheets and blanket (twin), a pillow, towel, washcloth, soap and other toiletries, sunscreen, a Bible, pen, and a flashlight batteries. A disposable camera is a lot of fun and help the family back home share the memories. Whatever you bring, we highly encourage you to **MARK ALL YOUR BELONGINGS WITH A PERMANENT MARKER.**
- **SPENDING MONEY:** We recommend placing \$10-20 in your child's Snack Shack account upon arrival. All unused monies are returned upon camper check-out. They will attend Snack Shack on most days. There is a complete list of items for sale in the Snack Shack on our website.
- **CONTACTING CAMPERS:** While phone calls and unannounced visits are not recommended, your camper will love to receive mail and will be encouraged to write at least one letter home. Placing a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope in your child's gear will facilitate a letter home. In case of sickness or emergency, we will call you. Should you call here with an emergency, your child will be contacted as soon as possible. We would ask that you kindly leave cell phones at home.
- **CHECK IN:** Sunday 2:00—4:00 PM CST **CHECK OUT:** Saturday at 10:00 AM (CST)
- **LOST and FOUND:** Just another reminder to pack with your camper so they know what is in the suitcase and what needs to come home. Remember to label all gear, and be sure and look through lost and found during check out.

Children are carefully supervised at all times, so please don't worry. Camp is a fun, important event. We are looking forward to a great camp season. Cedar Lake is a great place for making new friends as well as spending the week with someone you know. Look forward to seeing you soon!

- Travel for 3.5 miles. After passing Oak Grove Missionary Baptist Church, turn right onto Conatser Lane
- Bear Left at Fork
- Turn left at 2nd driveway on the left.
