Dear Parents or Sponsors,

Thank you for choosing to send your child/children to Cedar Lake Camp Day Camp. We look forward to seeing you and your child at registration. Please print this letter and use it for detailed information.

Here is a list of things you need to know for Day Camp

- Daily drop-off time is from 7:30-8:00 am. Drop off time on Monday may take a little longer because of processing registration. Please be prepared for that delay.
- Pick up is from 4:30-5:00 pm. (If you need to pick your child up earlier please let the director and counselor know ahead of time.)
- At pick up time make sure you sign the check out sheet for your child before taking them home.

What to bring to Day Camp

- If your child is 5 to 6 yr. old, they should bring a pillow and blanket for naptime.
- Bring warm clothes for cold or rainy days.
- We will let you know when to bring a flashlight for the cave.
- We have a snack shack time on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. At this time your child can buy a candy bar or a drink. If you wish for your child to be able to purchase items from the snack shack, then we suggest that you submit \$5.00 to \$10.00 for them to spend for the week. We put the money in a special fund under their name, and any unused money will be refunded to them on Friday. T-shirts are available in the snack shack at a cost of \$10
- Tennis shoes/closed toe shoes that they can wear on a hike.
- Bathing Suit or Trunks (one piece suit for girls please)
- Sandals for pool area
- Towel
- Bring an extra pair of clothes in case the first pair gets wet or dirty
- Bring either a sack lunch, or send \$20 (\$4 a day) for lunch that will be provided by the camp.

Do not Bring

- Radios
- Cell Phones
- Any electronic devices
- Inappropriate clothing (at our discretion)
- Clothing that you don't want to get dirty.
