Title: Gap Year Student, Cedar Lake Camp

Reporting Relationship: Executive Director, Associate Director, Office Manager

Overview and Purpose

This gap year program is designed to help you learn practical skills, grow in your faith, and explore God's call on your life. We are looking for young men and women who are interested in hands-on experience in camp ministry. Participants will work behind the scenes in areas including administrative, leadership, facilities, carpentry, event planning, food service, and a number of other ministry related skills.

Mission

The mission of Cedar Lake Camp and Children's Gospel Hour is to reach children with the gospel of Jesus Christ in order to lead them into a relationship with Him while nurturing and discipling a staff of young people into a lifestyle of ministry. This vision will be achieved through a variety of camps and retreats -- with the core of the ministry being found in the summer camp program.

Requirements

*This position requires 20 hours of service per week. Hours are flexible, allowing for opportunities to take classes and/or maintain a part time job. Hours will be discussed and approved with Camp's leadership taking into account the camp schedule and calendar first. There will be a one week break during Thanksgiving week and an additional two week break for Christmas. Other days off, family vacations, and personal time will be approved by camp leadership.

Tuition

This position requires a monthly payment of \$300 per month for 10 months/1 school year (August-May). This cost covers room and board, utilities, some food (during cooking retreats and seasonal camps), and travel expenses as required by camp. Student is responsible for their own food when it is not offered at camp. They are also responsible for their own laundry, cleaning, and phone. The annual CLC international mission trip is an option for additional tuition. Also available are opportunities to seek certifications in lifeguarding, CPR/first aid, and challenge course training.
